



Vocation Action Circle

Inspired by the charism of Regnum Christi, the goal of Vocation Action Circle (VAC) is to help evangelize the culture through the family by giving others the good news that God has a personal call and mission for your lives. Understanding this fundamental point is key to attracting a new generation of young people who desire to freely embrace their mission and purpose in life.

Marriage, priesthood, and consecrated life – each of these paths can lead to the fullness of one's Christian vocation. Christ desires that we respond to Him in freedom because love is not love unless it is free.

Vocation Action Circle (VAC) is committed to developing a network of committed lay people who are advocates for this vision of the Domestic Church. The family is the training ground for a new generation of mission-minded apostles who will impact the culture with the testimony of their lives through the power of the Gospel.

Foundational points in the work of a Vocation Advocate in VAC:

Prayer is the anchor and source of all our motivation. Unless the Lord builds the house, the builders labor in vain (Ps 127:1). Eucharistic Adoration for vocations in the starting point of all our work.

Our motivation as Vocation Advocates comes from our love for Christ and His Church. We desire to help the Church in her needs. We desire more than anything to help young people find the happiness and joy that comes from living according to God's plan for them, whatever that may be.

The family is the essential building block for a healthy society. We want to be a vehicle to support to any programs or initiatives that support the domestic Church.

Advocating for "vocation" is about all vocations". Regnum Christi and the Legionaries of Christ aspire to help young people discern God's call and their personal mission in life. We desire to support them in following that call no matter what that vocation may be.

Membership in Regnum Christi is not necessary to be involved with this apostolate.

How to Start?

- Gather those who have a similar interest in supporting the Domestic Church and vocations.
- Commit to prayer - both personally and as a team for this intention.
- Commit to first studying together one of the resources provided by VAC to lay the groundwork for this apostolate.
- Decide frequency of meetings.
